NFCA & Safety – The US Occupational Safety and Health Administration has a separate website section covering Scaffolding General Requirements in Section 29 CFR 1026.451. In Canada, the Canadian Center for Occupational Health and Safety also has Rolling Scaffold Safety Resources as is used in the fireproofing industry. Both the USA OSHA and Canadian OHSA cover scaffolding subjects in a FAQ format.
